- Photo (submitting an application allows the photo to be used in the award program).
- Clear description of community service activities undertaken
- 1000-1500 word typed response to the following question:
 1. “What do you feel is the most significant healthcare issue facing the Rochester Community and why?”
- Letters of recommendations are not required but recommended.
